



Limited Warranty — Painted Finishes

Warranty Grant

Enerfree's warrants that painted finishes applied to aluminum framing components supplied by Enerfree's will, under normal use and with the maintenance described below, meet the performance criteria in this document for the warranty period corresponding to the coating type applied, measured from the date of substantial completion of the project, provided that the warranty period will in no event begin later than six (6) months from the date of shipment. This finish warranty applies in addition to, and does not replace, the Limited Warranty — Materials & Workmanship (ENF-WTY-100), which continues to apply to the underlying framing.

Warranty Period and Performance Criteria

Coating Type	Standard	Warranty Period
PVDF / FEVE liquid coating	AAMA 2605	Ten (10) years
Powder coating	AAMA 2604	Five (5) years

During the applicable warranty period, the finish will not chalk beyond a No. 8 rating (No. 6 for white and light colours) measured per ASTM D4214 Method A; will not change colour by more than five (5) Hunter ΔE units measured per ASTM D2244, compared against an unexposed reference area of the same coating; and will not crack, check, or peel in a manner that visibly affects appearance when viewed at a distance of 3 metres (10 ft), excluding corrosion-related conditions.

Exclusions Specific to This Finish Warranty

- Damage caused by improper or abrasive cleaning agents, or by chemical cleaning agents not appropriate for painted architectural aluminum.
- Scratches, abrasion, or other damage caused by handling, shipping, or installation, or by contact with parts, gaskets, glazing materials, or sealants not supplied by Enerfree's.
- Damage occurring prior to installation due to improper storage, packaging, or site protection, including condensation damage from improper repackaging.
- Corrosion or finish damage caused by exposure to salt spray, salt fog, or aggressive industrial atmospheres beyond normal urban or suburban conditions.
- Colour variation inherent to metallic or mica-flake finishes, which are not measurable against the colour-change criterion above and are not covered by it.
- Any cause of damage excluded under the Materials & Workmanship warranty (ENF-WTY-100), which applies concurrently to the underlying framing.

Maintenance Requirement

The Customer is responsible for establishing and maintaining a routine cleaning program for painted surfaces, consistent with AAMA 609 & 610, at minimum annually under normal conditions and quarterly in coastal or heavy-industrial environments where salt spray, salt fog, or airborne contaminants are present. Failure to maintain, and be able to reasonably demonstrate, such a program voids this finish warranty. Normal weathering — gradual fading or chalking within the tolerances stated above, resulting from ordinary sunlight and weather exposure — is expected and is not a defect.



Remedy Specific to This Finish Warranty

The sole remedy for a breach of this finish warranty is, at Enerfree's option, refinishing of the affected material using standard finishing practices, or repayment of the original purchase price paid for the affected material. Refinishing performed under this warranty does not extend or restart the original warranty period. This provision supplements, and does not replace, the general remedy and liability terms below.

Claims Procedure

To make a claim under this Limited Warranty, the Customer must give Enerfree's written notice within thirty (30) days of discovering the alleged defect, describing the defect and its location on the project. Enerfree's must be given a reasonable opportunity to inspect the affected material before any repair, replacement, or refinishing is undertaken by any party other than Enerfree's or a party Enerfree's authorizes in writing. Repair or restoration work carried out by the Customer or any other party without Enerfree's prior written authorization voids this Limited Warranty with respect to the affected material.

Remedy and Limitation of Liability

The Customer's sole and exclusive remedy under this Limited Warranty is, at Enerfree's sole option, repair of the affected material, replacement or refinishing with material of equivalent kind and quality, or repayment of the original purchase price paid to Enerfree's for the affected material. This warranty does not cover labour, removal, freight, or other costs associated with repair, replacement, or refinishing. Material repaired, replaced, or refinished under this warranty is warranted only for the remainder of the original warranty period, not from the date of the repair.

Enerfree's aggregate liability under this Limited Warranty will not exceed the original purchase price paid to Enerfree's for the affected material. Enerfree's is not liable for indirect, incidental, special, or consequential damages of any kind, including loss of use, loss of profit, or loss of goodwill, arising from any defect whether or not covered by this Limited Warranty.

No Other Warranties

Except as expressly stated in this document, Enerfree's makes no other warranties, express or implied, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, with respect to the products described herein. This is the only warranty made in connection with the sale of the affected products; no representative of Enerfree's is authorized to make any other warranty or representation, and no oral or written statement other than this document and a project-specific warranty confirmation signed by an authorized Enerfree's representative will be binding on Enerfree's.

Governing Law

This Limited Warranty is governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario and the federal laws of Canada applicable therein, without regard to conflict-of-law principles.

Entire Agreement

This document, together with any project-specific warranty confirmation issued in writing by Enerfree's, constitutes the entire warranty agreement between Enerfree's and the Customer with respect to the products described herein, and supersedes any prior or contemporaneous oral or written representations concerning warranty terms.
